- 3) Electricity and oil is an additional charge, meter read and payable on-site.
- 4) A cash security deposit of €100 must be given to the site manager on arrival. This will be returned to you provided the on site terms and conditions of the rental have been complied with. Costs of repairs caused by negligence will be debited from your security deposit with an additional charge where this is insufficient NB this has already been paid by Oceandivers.
- 5) The proprietors are not responsible for any loss of valuables during your stay or left after departure.

DIRECTIONS TO DOWNINGS COASTGUARD COTTAGES

- 1. Take the nearest national route to Letterkenny.
- 2. On arrival in Letterkenny, follow signposts for the N56.
- 3. Continue on the N56 via Kilmacrenan and Termon until you reach the outskirts of Creeslough. At this point take a road to your right (R245), signposted Carrigart / Downings.
- 4. Continue on this road until you reach Carrigart. On the outskirts of Carrigart there is a large stone-faced church on your left. Drive straight passed the church (do not take the left beside it). The road goes down a small hill, then up, and then back down again entering Carrigart. Take the sharp left turn before the village, signposted Downings (Na Dúnaibh) / Rosapenna (R248).
- 5. Continue on this road for about 1.5km (1 mile) until you reach a junction with two roads to your right (one goes up a hill and the other is on level ground). There is a large sign in the middle of the junction saying "Welcome to the Rosapenna Golf Resort" and another large sign behind it, with a rightward pointing arrow, directing you to the "Coastguard Holiday Park". Follow this sign taking the road that goes up the hill.

Note: If you pass either the Rosapenna Golf Pavilion or the Rosapenna Hotel on your left, you have missed the right turn for our cottages. You

should turn back immediately in the direction of Carrigart taking the first sharp left <u>after</u> the Rosapenna Hotel and / or Rosapenna Golf Pavilion. Then proceed with directions as below.

6. Continue on this road taking the third entrance to the right (sign for Irish Marine Emergency Service Coast and Cliff Rescue at our entrance). There is a stone wall around the perimeter of the site, a red-bricked coastguard station to the right of our entrance, and within the site there are two round stone-faced buildings.
